He obtained his M.D. and Ph.D. degrees at Yonsei University, followed by a clinical training at Severance Hospital in Korea. He has research training experience at the University of Tokyo, Japan, as well as at the National Institutes of Health, Bethesda, USA. He has also worked at Mass General Hospital and Harvard Medical School as a visiting Associate Professor of Medicine and is now an Adjunct Professor at Icahn School of Medicine at Mount Sinai.</p> <p>His research focuses on the understanding of molecular mechanism of many genetic rare diseases. He is conducting several Rare Disease Registry Studies in Korea and wishes to expand that to neighbouring countries. He has recently discovered several exciting novel mutations of genes, which might be associated with the rare diseases. He is trying to apply the acquired knowledge to more common diseases.</p>
