Short Bio (in 150 words):	<p>Professor Hung-Yuan Li, a leading endocrinologist and professor at National Taiwan University Hospital, completed his medical degree, residency, and fellowships at NTU, also holding a Master's and Ph.D. from the Graduate Institute of Clinical Medicine. He has held key roles with the Diabetes Association of R.O.C. (DAROC), including as an executive board member and editor-in-chief of the Formosan Journal of Endocrinology and Metabolism. As CEO and director of the Formosan Diabetes Care Foundation, he advances diabetes education and public awareness. Professor Li's research focuses on diabetes epidemiology and translational studies, with an emphasis on developing community-based cohorts to advance diabetes screening, diagnosis, and biomarker discovery. Recently, his focus expanded to epidemiological and translational studies in gestational diabetes. For his achievements, he received the Professor Fang-Wu Chen Outstanding Research Award from DAROC and ESROC in 2011 and the Masato Kasuga Award for Outstanding Scientific Achievement from AASD in 2023.</p>
