He has acted as a Topic Editor for a Research Topic “Current Status and Emerging Health Problems Associated with Diabetes, in Asia and in Developing Countries” for Frontiers in Endocrinology in 2019. He has been listed as the World’s Top 2% Scientists in six consecutive years from 2019 to 2024 in both the Career-long and the Single-year categories (Stanford University). He is ranked as the Top 0.1% of World Expert in Metformin according to Expertscape and has been bestowed the highest honor “Outstanding Contribution Award” by the Diabetes Association of Republic of China (Taiwan) on March 20, 2022.
