He has been involved in several intervention studies in patients with overt diabetic nephropathy aiming at improving the prognosis. He was coordinator of PROTON aiming at personalizing prevention of diabetic nephropathy, the STENO1 and member of several trial steering groups and guideline committees.</p> <p>He has co-authored &gt;700 papers and his h-index are 86. He received the Minkowski prize in 2005 and the Golgi prize in 2016 both from the EASD and the E. Bierman award from ADA and the Harmon Medal from European Society of Endocrinology. Past president of the Danish Endocrine Society, and of the European Diabetic Nephropathy Study group and chairman of the Danish National Diabetes Registry</p>
