| <b>Short Bio (in 150 words):</b>                           | <p>Dr. Boyko's research focuses on the epidemiology of diabetes mellitus and its complications. He leads the Japanese American Community Diabetes Study, a prospective study of risk factors for type 2 diabetes that focuses on metabolic measurements and body composition. He also leads The Seattle Diabetic Foot Study, a longitudinal investigation of the risk of foot ulcer and amputation in relation to person- and limb-specific measurements. He has held national and international positions including Associate Editor of <i>Diabetes Care</i>; Chair of the NIH KNOD study section; 2013 President of the International Diabetes Epidemiology Group; Programme Chair of the 2019 International Diabetes Federation Congress (Busan, Korea); and Co-Chair of the IDF Diabetes Atlas 10<sup>th</sup> and 11<sup>th</sup> Editions. He has received awards from the American Diabetes Association, the Kelly West Award in 2013 and the Roger E. Pecoraro Award in 2021. Throughout his career he has remained active clinically as a practicing internist.</p> |
