Her clinical expertise encompasses a wide range of endocrine and metabolic disorders, with a particular focus on rare adrenal conditions, including paragangliomas, Cushing’s syndrome, and primary aldosteronism. Her research explores the genetic and molecular mechanisms underlying these disorders, particularly the hereditary aspects of paragangliomas. Currently pursuing a Ph.D. at the Graduate Institute of Clinical Medicine, Dr. Wu has published extensively in high-impact journals, contributing to advancements in the understanding and management of adrenal diseases. In recognition of her academic achievements, she received the 2022 Outstanding Research Paper Award from the Endocrine Society and Diabetes Association of the Republic of China. Dr. Wu is dedicated to integrating cutting-edge research into clinical practice to improve.</p>
