His previous roles include Chair of International Diabetes Federation Western Pacific Region, President of the Chinese Diabetes Society, President of Chinese Endocrinologist's Association, President of Chinese Geriatric Endocrine and Metabolism Society, and Vice President of IDF Global.</p>

Prof. Ji received his MD from Beijing Medical University in 1986 and completed his postdoctoral at Joslin Diabetes Center, Harvard Medical School. His research interests include genetics of diabetes, translational research and new pharmacological treatment of diabetes and obesity. He has served as Principal Investigator in over 90 clinical trials of new diabetes / obesity medicine and devices and authored more than 600 original papers in peer-reviewed journals. He was named by Elsevier as "Highly Cited Scholars in China" (2020-2023) and Selected into the top 2% of the world's top scientists in 2024 by Stanford-Elsevier list of the world's most-cited scholars

Prof. Ji is Chief Editor of Chinese Diabetes Journal and a member of the editorial board of Diabetes Care, Journal of Diabetes, Diabetes Research and Clinical Practice, Metabolism, Diabetes Technology & Therapeutics, Metabolism, International Journal of Diabetes.
